He has made only the absolutely necessary corrections; I doubt that you will even notice that corrections have been made and I am very confident that you will be pleased with the job. No changes whatever have been made as regards content or style. As soon as I have your reply to my previous letter, I will send the manuscriot to the printer. There will be very careful proof-reading. To return once more to the title. We are convinced that neither Philosopher Lenin nor Lenin Philosopher will do; particularly not, if the sub-title "A critical Examination of the Philosophical Basis of Leninism" is added. One cannot mention Lenin twice on a title page, and it is obvious, that if one speaks about Leninism one speaks about Lenin. We would like to keep the subtitle, however, and substitute another first title: Maybe you can agree to the following:
